CROCHET 'PAPER CHAIN' GARLAND

MEASUREMENTS (per link)

Width: approx 4cm

Length (seamed and laying flat): approx 10cm

Bendigo Woollen Mills Yarn Requirements:

Classic, Luxury, Dolce, Prism, Cotton, or other Bendigo Woollen Mills 8 ply: around 7 grams per link

ACCESSORIES

A 4.00mm crochet hook or size hook to give correct tension. Tension is not essential for this item but weights and measurements are based on this tension. If you are working to a different tension you may need more or less yarn than specified.

Tighter tension will give you firmer links that look more like a paper chain. If using Cotton 8 ply, we suggest using a 3.25 or 3.5mm hook to get a firmer, less drapey fabric.

TENSION

20 tr to 10cm over treble crochet fabric, using a 4.00mm hook.

Note: this pattern uses Australian/UK crochet terms

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning, **ch** = chain, **cont** = continue, **tr** = treble crochet, **st/s** = stitch/es

LINK

Using 4.00mm Hook, chain 43.

1st Row: Working into the back bump of the chain, miss 3 (count as tr), tr into each remaining st to end of row... 40 tr.

2nd Row: 3ch in first st (counts as first tr), 1tr in each st to end of row.

Repeat last row. (Three rows total including foundation row.)

Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

First link: Seam the short sides together to form a loop. Ensure not to twist when joining side seams.

For each subsequent link, thread it through the previous link before seaming, forming a chain.
